2017 - 2018 Trip Sign-up Form

CONDITIONS & AGREEMENTS: All participants must be a member, spouse, or dependent child member of the Nashville Ski Club, Inc., unless exempted by special vote of the Board of Directors. The departure date, time, and place will be given to each participant prior to departure. It will be the responsibility of each individual to be at the departure point at the announced time or it will be his or her responsibility, financially and otherwise, to make his or her travel arrangements. The Nashville Ski Club, Travel Agent, and Airline will not be responsible for the possible late arrival of the skiers at the ski resort or for the late arrival of the return flight which might sometimes happen due to bad weather conditions during the winter or for other reasons beyond their control; therefore, each participant must make allowance in case the return flight is late. Furthermore, the NSC and the Travel Agency shall also not be liable for the loss of personal items or luggage. Travel insurance is available and recommended. The following are special conditions which apply to this trip:

1. The trip committee and Travel Agency reserve the right to refuse a reservation to anyone upon a complete report to the Board of Directors of the NSC.
2. Children under 21 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or an adult on the trip and if an adult, the adult must agree in writing to be responsible for the conduct of the child.
3. NSC and the Travel Agency offer the trip in good faith. Neither can guarantee snow conditions.
4. A trip will not be cancelled at departure time because of snow conditions at the designated ski resort.
5. Cancellation without penalty will not be granted because of snow conditions at the designated ski resort.
6. The trips are to be sold exactly as listed. There will be no deviation.
7. The reservation blank must be completed and signed before a name will be placed on the passenger list.
8. All payments must be made on the due date. If an individual becomes 30 days delinquent on any payment, the trip leader may assess the cancellation fee and remove the individual from the passenger list. Any overpayment, if any, would then be refunded. See the individual payment schedules for each trip.
9. Once an individual from the waiting list accepts a seat on the passenger list, that individual will be subject to all previously stated conditions including cancellation fees in effect at that time. No refunds will be made for unused portions of your trip including unused lift tickets, early check-out, late arrival, unused airline tickets, unused ground transfer, etc.
10. All cancellations must be made in writing. The postmark will be used to determine the cancellation date. The letter must have a regular postage stamp.
11. Regular payments made by parties who cancel can be applied to the payment schedule of substitutes if such substitutes require exactly the same lodging and transportation arrangements. The responsibilities for providing such substitutes shall not fall on trip leaders or travel agents. Substitutes are permissible only in event of no waiting list.
12. Each trip shall have a designated MINIMUM cancellation fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), and shall be payable for any cancellation regardless of the reason.
13. If there is not a replacement, the TOTAL cancellation charge will be the MINIMUM cancellation fee plus any amount that cannot be recovered from deposits made by the NSC or the Travel Agency or supplier, such as airseat, lodging, land transfers, lift tickets, trip administration, or optional events.
14. If an air ticket has been issued to and paid for by a cancelling person, and a replacement person is not found who can utilize that ticket, then the cancelling person shall be solely responsible for the disposition of that ticket. If possible, the cancelling person will cooperate in transferring any tickets to a replacement person.
15. NSC shall have no responsibility for any injury, damages, loss, or inconvenience on any trips, regardless of the reason. Release of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

I hereby appoint the Nashville Ski Club, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Club") to perform necessary acts deemed desirable in connection with planning and leading any ski trips or other social/activity functions in my behalf. I understand the Club acts as coordinator only and accepts no responsibility for the services of any person or agent, ski area, airline or motor coach, hotel or condominium, ski council or association, or any organization whatsoever rendering any of the services or accommodations being offered on any trip or activity. Ski trip and other activity fees are based on current tariffs and are subject to change without notice. The Club accepts no responsibility in whole or in part for any delays, delayed departures or arrivals, missed plane or carrier connections, loss, damage or injury to person or property, mechanical defect or failure of any nature howsoever caused, or for any substitution of hotels or common carrier, with or without notice or for any additional expenses occasioned thereby.

I fully understand that the Club is a voluntary association run by volunteer officers and Board Members who have no special or professional training in conducting ski trips and other activities. By participating, I do not rely on the expertise of any director, officer, activity coordinator, legal counsel or the agents of any of the foregoing; delivery of goods and services as described is the responsibility of the contracted vendors.

Further, I realize that skiing, as well as many other outdoor activities, has innate danger that may result in physical injury or death. I acknowledge that these risks may be known or unknown. Since safety is directly tied to my physical ability and skill to participate in any sport, I hereby release the Nashville Ski Club, Inc., its officers, directors, trip leaders, event leaders, and their agents, from any liability in connection with injuries or physical and equipment damages I may incur in relation to my participation in any event. Further, I acknowledge that the Nashville Ski Club, Inc. offers a number of other activities and social events unrelated to skiing, including but not limited to, events such as rafting, camping, hiking, beach trips, golf outings, volleyball, picnics, boating (including water skiing), monthly dinner outings, happy hours, parties and other social events. My participation in any and all such activities, or any activities not mentioned above which are approved by the board of Directors, is at MY OWN RISK, and I recognize that many such activities involve dangers that could result in physical injury or death. I agree to hold harmless and release the Nashville Ski Club, Inc., its Board of Directors, officers, trip leaders, event leaders, legal counsel and agents from any responsibility, financial or otherwise for any liability sustained by me as a result of participation in these non-skiing related events. Further, I recognize, understand and agree that there may be alcoholic beverages provided, served or made available at any or all club functions, including the monthly meetings. I take full and unconditional responsibility for my own actions and any consequences thereof, foreseeable or unforeseeable as a result of the consumption of alcohol by myself or others and further agree to hold harmless and release the Nashville Ski Club, Inc., its Board of Directors, officers, trip leaders, event leaders, legal counsel and agents from any liability as a result of such actions and/or consequences.
